## **Change: Climatic or Apocalyptic?**

It is generally thought that most of the recent upheavals in meteorology are the result of abuse of the planet through human activity. But could it also be possible they are traceable to the imminent beginning of the final outcome predicted in the Bible – judgment upon the multiple abuses by humanity, as divine patience comes to an end? Many have believed these words; have obeyed, have repented of their sins and have accepted the Lord Jesus as their Saviour.

At the moment these lines are being written, there is still time to believe and be saved. By the time you read them, it could already be too late, so I am in a hurry to send them out so that you will respond in time.

Acts 16:31: Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ and thou shalt be saved.

John 3:18: He that believes on Him is not condemned, but he that believes not is condemned already because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.
