Ending the debate

People who deny the hand of the Creator and often the fact of a universal flood (with its abundant geological support and convincing fossil record of a cataclysmic inundation) are enshrouded in an intellectual fog. They talk of millions or billions of years of evolution. But Jesus Christ, the Son of God, clearly confirmed in His documented talks these two undeniable facts (the Creation and the Deluge). He's the one who puts to rest the delusion of counter-arguments.

Faith is the Game Changer
