A Forecast To Prepare For

If we consider the weather forecasts, thanks to the satellites in the heaven above us, we can stay informed hourly of tomorrow's weather with remarkable precision. Nonetheless, even this stunning precision of the technology wanes proportionally with time and the longer the term the more imprecise it gets. Jesus said: "Heaven and earth shall pass away, but my words shall not pass away" (Matthew 24:35). His words will come to pass exactly as He said, and our forecast is, that it will be very soon! To escape, there is no refuge available to us like in Noah's days, but there is one in the Saviour Who, by his death on the cross and his shed blood paid for the sins of those who put their trust in Him. To these He has promised eternal salvation and a part with Him in his Kingdom. "Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners" (1 Timothy 1:15).
